## Convictions against the law

When students apply to sit the State Examination at the end of the New Zealand Diploma in Enrolled Nursing programme they are required to make a declaration about whether they have ever been convicted of any offence against the law. It is our policy to alert applicants to this requirement and to ask them to make a similar declaration when they first apply.

This information is sought so that potential problems regarding registration as a nurse and access to clinical experiences may be discussed with applicants before their application is processed. It may be used as part of the selection process. This will be discussed with you at an interview.

As all accepted applicants are police vetted through the enrolment process, it is important that this initial declaration is correct. If an applicant provides information that is provided to be false/misleading, the application/enrolment may be declined/withdrawn. When accepted onto the programme you will be asked to complete and return a NZ Police Vetting Request and Consent form before or at your orientation. Your consent to disclosure will be entered by Ara onto the NZ Police Licensing and Vetting Service, database and returned in confidence to the Head of Department or delegated authority.
